■ Research Fellows/Research Associates (Ref: IHP/HR/1706)

Should have an advanced university degree such as a PhD or equivalent degree, or in exceptional circumstances a Masters degree in relevant fields; is expected to lead projects, supervise junior staff and develop their own work areas; must be fluent in English, with strong written and verbal communication skills. Fluency in Sinhala and/or Tamil is an added advantage.

■ Research Assistants/Research Officers (Ref: IHP/HR/1707)

Should have a first class/upper-second degree in a relevant fields; are expected to support senior staff in data collection and quantitative analysis. Familiarity with analytical software such as Stata is an added advantage, but not essential.

■ Field investigators (Ref: IHP/HR/1708)

Should have a B.Sc. degree in Nursing, Health Sciences or related field. Community or field or survey experience will be an added advantage. Successful applicants will participate in a large national population survey that IHP and partners will be conducting during 2016–2017.

■ Medical Pre-Interns (Ref: IHP/HR/1709)

Should have a second class or above in the final MBBS examination; be computer literate and have good communication skills
