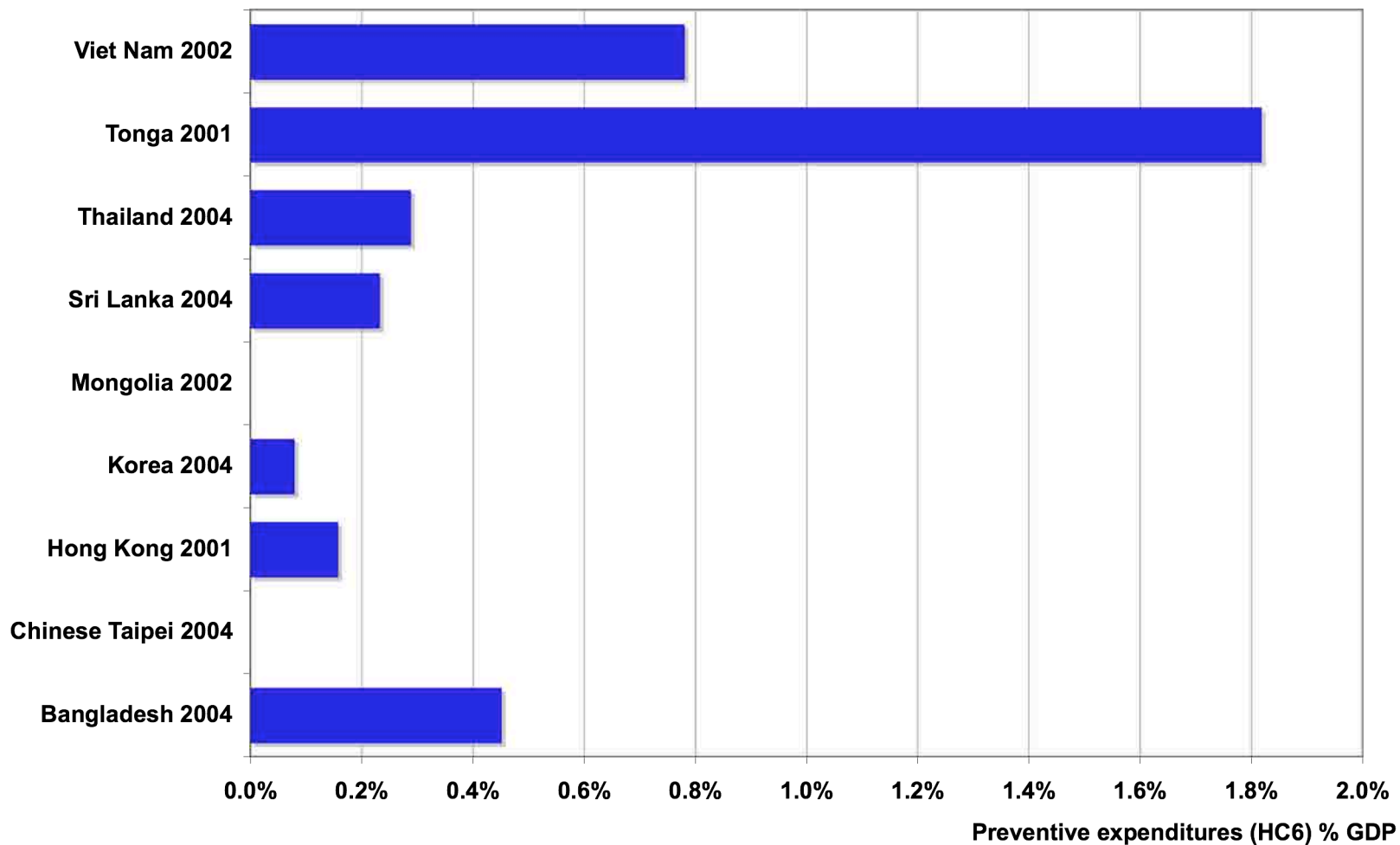

- Country projects in India, Indonesia, Thailand, Sri Lanka

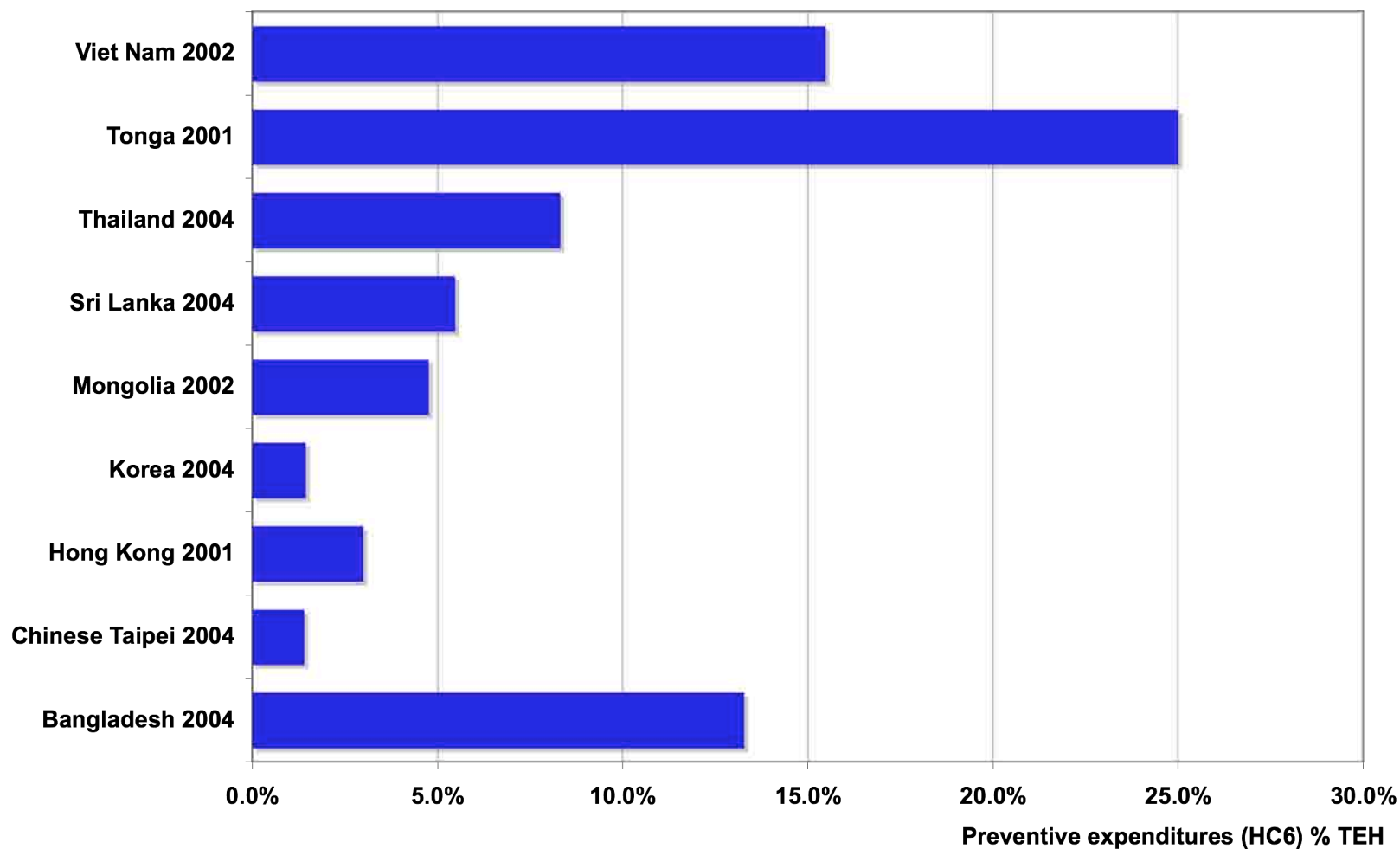
Data Sources for Sri Lanka

- Central Government Electronic Accounts data:
 - Central MOH programs
- Questionnaire survey of local governments
 - Local government programs
- Extrapolation from cost studies to analyze:
 - Preventive expenditures in MCH clinics

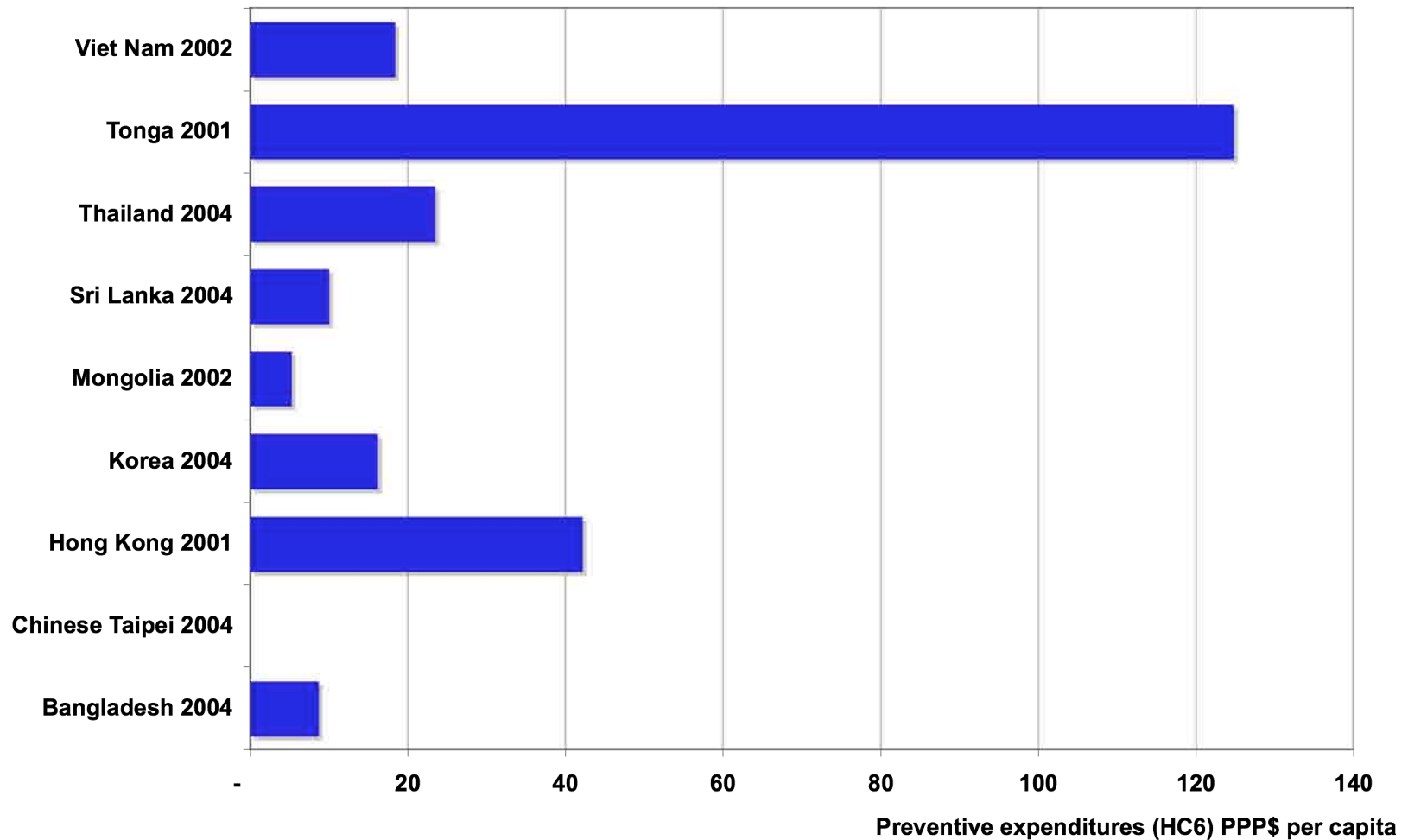
HC6 Expenditures (% GDP)



HC6 Expenditures (% TEH)

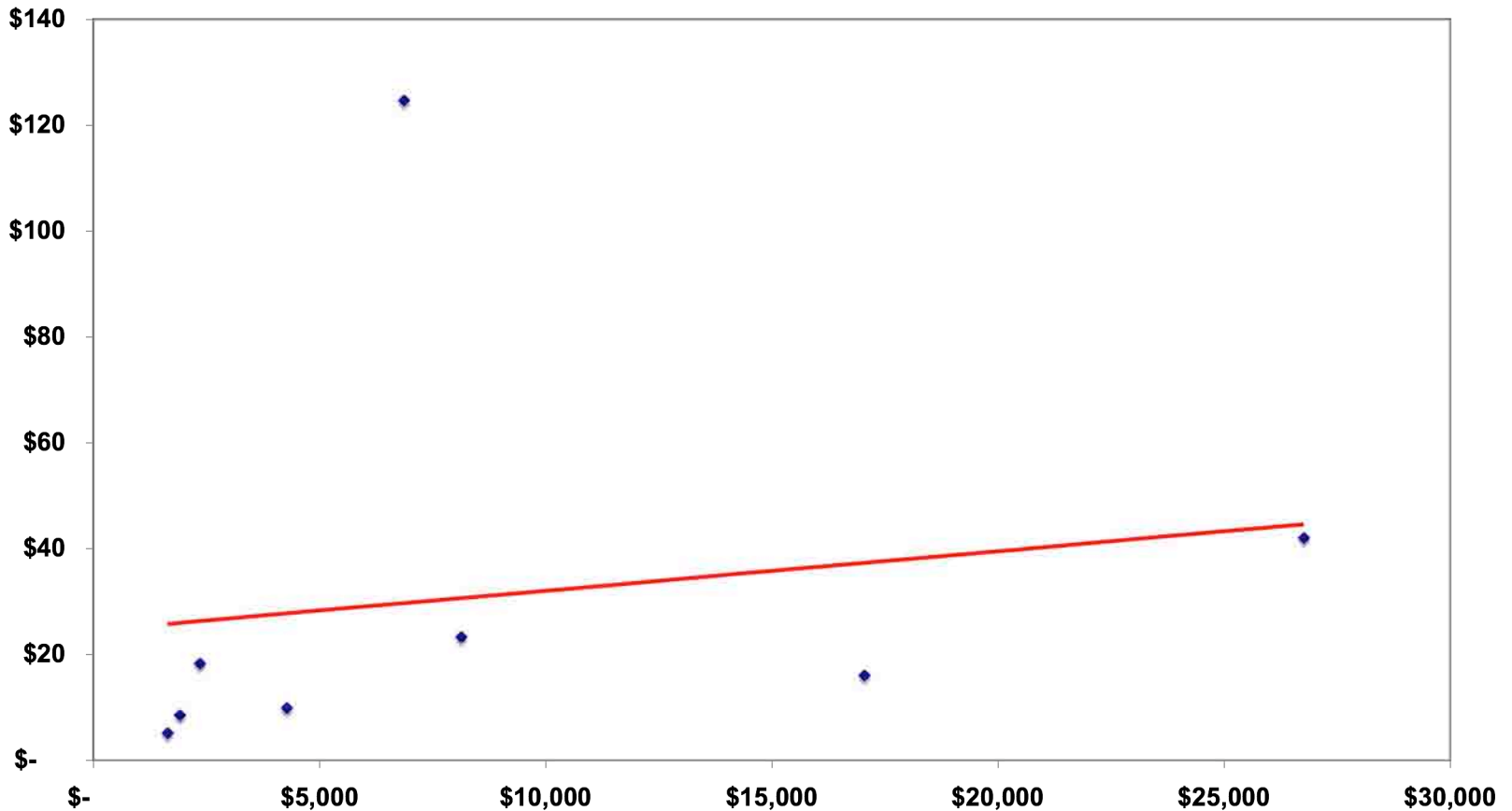


HC6 Expenditures (PPP\$ per capita)

Issues

- Large variations in expenditures noted already
 - Could be real differences, but may be differences in methods and classification
- Need to decompose HC6 expenditures further to two digit level to identify which components are important
- Are levels of preventive spending related to outcomes?
